2. DUTIES

2.1 VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT II (GRADE LEVEL.04)

- Controlling traffic and enforcing the provisions of the Road Traffic Services Act and other Road Traffic Laws and Regulations;
- 2.1.2. Deterring and apprehending road traffic offenders;
- 2.1.3. Clearing obstructions on any part of the roads; and
- 2.1.4. General duties that may be assigned from time to time.

2.2 VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT GRADE I (GRADE LEVEL 05)

- 2.2.1 Controlling traffic and enforcing the provisions of the Road Traffic Services Act and other Road Traffic Laws and Regulations;
- 2.2.2. Deterring and apprehending road traffic offenders;
- 2.2.3. Clearing obstructions on any part of the roads; and
- 2.2.4. General duties that may be assigned from time to time.

2.3 SENIOR VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT (GRADE LEVEL 06)

- 2.3.1 Educating drivers, motorist, and the general public on the proper use of the roads;

3.1 VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT II (GRADE LEVEL 04)

3.1.1 By direct appointment of a candidate that possesses any of the following Ordinary Level qualifications: WASCE, GCE, NECO, Certificate with at least four (4) credits obtained at one sitting or credits at two sittings which must include English Language, Mathematics, or Physics.

3.2 VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT GRADE I (GRADE LEVEL 05)

- 3.2.1 By promotion of a confirmed and suitable Vehicle Inspection Assistant who has served at least (2) two years on the grade.
- 3.2.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Group E Driver's License.

3.3 SENIOR VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT (GRADE LEVEL 06)

- 3.3.1 By promotion of a suitable Vehicle Inspection Assistant Grade I who has served at least (2) two years on the grade level; and
- 3.3.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Group E Driver's License

3.4 CHIEF VEHICLE INSPECTION ASSISTANT (GRADE LEVEL 07)

3.4.1 By promotion of a suitable Senior Vehicle Inspection Assistan who has served at least (2) two years on the grade level.

3.5 CHIEF VEHICLE INSPECTION OFFICER (GRADE LEVEL 13)

- 3.5.1 By promotion of a confirmed and suitable Principal Vehicle Inspection Officer who has served at least (3) three years on the grade level; and
- 3.5.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Grade 'E' Class Driver's License.

3.6 ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (VEHICLE INSPECTION) (GRADE LEVEL 14

- 3.6.1 By promotion of a confirmed and suitable Chief Vehicle Inspection Officer who has served at least (3) three years on the grade level; and
- 3.6.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Grade 'E' Class Driver's License.

3.7 DEPUTY DIRECTOR (VEHICLE INSPECTION) (GRADE LEVEL 15)

- 3.7.1 By promotion of a confirmed and suitable Assistant Director (Vehicle Inspection) Officer who has served at least (3) three years on the grade level; and
- 3.7.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Grade 'E' Class Driving License.

3.8 DIRECTOR (VEHICLE INSPECTION) (GRADE LEVEL 16)

- 3.8.1 By promotion of a confirmed and suitable Deputy Director who has served at least (4) four years on the grade level; and
- 3.8.2 Candidate must also possess a valid Grade 'E' Class Driver's License.
